- Purpose:**

 - Prophetic Voice (Speaking into our present with a mind to God's future).
 - Resourcing (Ensuring that the necessary resources are available: calling, training and equipping new leaders within the church).
 - Co-ordination (Making it happen effectively and efficiently).
