### **Sunday Service in church cancelled (for the time being)**

In view of the very high levels of infection at the present time, the Parochial Church Council has decided to suspend Sunday Services in church; consequently there will NOT be a service in church this coming Sunday. The situation will be reviewed as soon as possible; it is thought that this will be when the government conducts its own review of the Covid-19 situation on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> February.

The good news is that on-line services on the church website WILL CONTINUE. Go to the website at <https://saintmichaelsbramcote.com> and click on the link. Each service will be available from Sunday and for the whole of the following week.

The other good news is that the opportunity for private prayer in church on weekdays WILL CONTINUE. PCC considered that the risks of infection under these circumstances are far lower than on a Sunday when many more people attend at the same time. This means that the church will still be open and there will still be the opportunity to donate to the foodbank. Stewards will continue to be present to welcome you to church between 10:00am and 12noon from Monday to Friday.

Reflections on a Bible passage WILL CONTINUE to be available on the church website every weekday. These are compiled by our Clergy and Reader team and are geared to the present time and circumstances.
