Overall

Church - Children and Families

- Build strong positive relationships with children, young people and their families who are involved in the life of the church, and help to create a strong 'whole church family'.
- Coordinate and lead the team for the discipling, pastoring and teaching of children and young people aged 0-18, including Sunday activities.
- Take part in intergenerational worship in coordination with the Clergy and Reader team, with the opportunity to lead and preach.
- Develop the work within family ministry such as parenting support and Bible study.

Community - Children and Families

- Continue to build on the link with our church school, Bramcote C of E Primary, including the collaborated planning and taking of school assemblies, and develop links with other schools in the area.
- Liaise with the groups that facilitate outreach/serve the community.
- Develop the strategy for outreach to children, young people and their families, bearing in mind both current practice and life after Covid 19.

Team / Planning/ Administration

- Be a valued member of the overall Ministry Team (Clergy and Readers) and participate in staff meetings.
- Attend regular review meetings with line manager (Incumbent) to discuss planning, implementation, progress and CPD.
- Plan, organize and lead, in association with the Incumbent, all activities relating to our work with children, young people and their families.
- Ensure all safeguarding policies are adhered to, because we are committed to the safeguarding, care and nurture of everyone within our church.
- Lead and enthuse the team of volunteers working with children, young people and their families.
