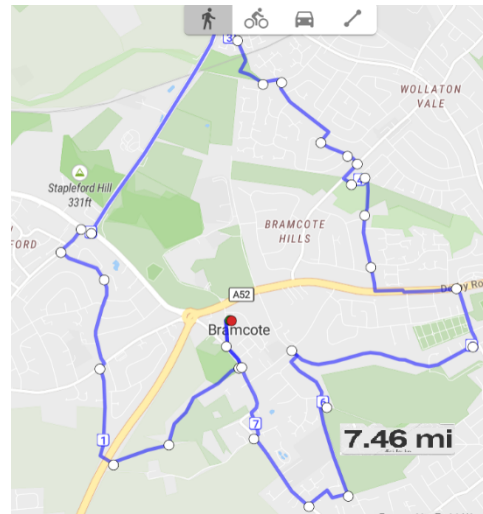
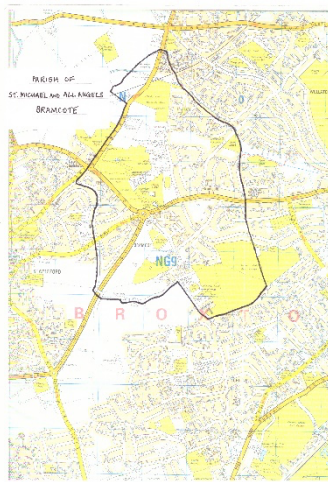


Prayer Walking around the Bramcote Parish Boundary

Saturday 27th May 2023



We will be Prayer Walking the Parish boundary, or as close by as feasible, bearing in mind roadways and surfaces, on Saturday 27th May, starting from the church carpark at **10.00am**. In previous years, it's been a very enjoyable time: do come and join in! Start and leave the walk at any point along the 7.5mile route - the (approx) times we'll be at the various points along the way are listed below, including refreshments at Pat Ashworth's home from 12noon to 12.45pm. We pause at various places along the route to pray for the people in the homes, businesses and venues we can see from that point. Walk as much or as little of the route as you like! If you would like to join us, these are the approximate times. (If you would like me to share our location with your phone, contact me beforehand by email, as above)

- 10.00am Meet at St Michael's, in the church car park from 09h50
We'll then be setting off **promptly at 10.00am**, up through King Gerges Park
- 10.45am Ewe Lamb Lane - junction with Derby Road
- 11.05am Coventry Lane - junction with Ilkeston Road
- 11.30am Sharnford Way - junction with Coventry Lane
- 11.50am Latimer Road - junction with Grangewood Road
- 12 noon - 12.45pm Pat Ashworth's home, Rivergreen Crescent
- 13.00pm Sandy Lane - junction with Cranston Road
- 13.10pm Sandy Lane - junction with Derby Road
- 13.25pm Briskly and briefly out of Parish, the junction of Beeston Fields Drive and Wollaton Rd
- 13.45pm Claremont Avenue – near junction with Beeston Fields Drive
- 14.05pm Kingsbridge Way - junction with Chilwell Lane
- 14.20pm Common Lane - junction with Chilwell Lane
- 14.30pm Arrive back at St Michael's
